### **Conversation about TikTok Challenges**

Highlighting something to stop it can risk increasing it, but with October's challenge being "slap a teacher" or "slap a staff member" (even as educators are working hard for students) I feel compelled to communicate with our families about the nationwide trend, especially through TikTok, of students committing inappropriate, often criminal actions, and posting videos of themselves doing so on social media. I would encourage you to read the list. The challenges are offensive and wrong on many levels. Our middle schools saw a bit of September's challenge ("Vandalize school bathrooms"), and addressed it. Future months' challenges get worse.

Hallmarks of our district and school communities are character, respect, and integrity, emphasized including through Responsive Classroom and C.A.R.E.S. in elementary school and our house structure, team meetings, and Advisory in middle school, which enable discussion of topics including social media. The first week of October in our state is the Week of Respect, which our schools will mark next week in various ways, including with the message that respect is important every week and every day.

Please consider, especially for our middle school parents, talking with your children about these challenges. Any students involved could face school disciplinary actions and criminal consequences, as the challenges include vandalism, violence, and sexual harassment. Related topics for conversation would be appropriate uses of technology, social media, and our digital footprints. We appreciate this teamwork as children benefit from the partnership of schools and families.
