Black History Month

Our district stands in solidarity with the over 17 historically Black colleges and universities (HBCUs) recently targeted with bomb threats and active shooter threats. These despicable acts are intended to sow fear and disrupt education, which is a means of increased opportunity. That this assault coincides with Black History Month, and a national conversation about the possibility of our first black female Supreme Court Justice, further underlines the importance of this month as recognition of the contributions of African Americans to our country. Proactive notification for whenever the state mask mandate ends

Due to the current state mask mandate in all NJ schools, districts are not permitted to go mask optional at this time. The recent 30 day emergency extension by Gov. Murphy due to end Feb. 10 may be extended again. At the same time, next week, next month, eventually, it may revert to districts to determine their own path (masks optional or required). Whenever the mask mandate ends, if the decision is up to local districts, ETSD will go mask optional as a district for all students and staff, based on individual choice, and continue to assess and evaluate based on data as part of ongoing consideration of all aspects of what we do. Masks would still be welcome and encouraged. But it would be difficult for our district, any district, to enforce masking, when our Governor, NJ Department

of Health, and NJ Department of Education were not requiring it. Reasons on the "masks optional" arm of the scale start to outweigh those on the other. Among them, wearing masks impedes communication, making it harder to hear, be heard, to see, and be seen. Seeing, hearing, being heard, being seen, these are critical components to the healthy and wholesome development of children. Our earliest lessons as infants are learned through facial expressions. A parent smiling at and nuzzling a baby, the baby mimicking the smile back...it is difficult to overstate the importance of that connection in our core. How does learning go when faces are cut in half? Empathy? Understanding and human connection? All are needed for overall health and survival. After so long, and ever longer, it becomes more and more difficult to deny that choice.

Our 2021-22 <u>ETSD Safe Return Plan</u> is to follow state guidance regarding masks, and at some point the state mask mandate will end. I share this now for the benefit of clarity and advanced notice.

2021-22 and 2022-23 Calendars

Our <u>2021-22 ETSD Calendar</u> has been adjusted due to the snow make up days accrued thus far. Please note, June 7, already a day of no school for students due to teacher in-service, is now our next available snow make up day, if needed. The intent with this change is to avoid having to make up school days during Spring Break.

Our <u>2022-23 ETSD District Calendar DRAFT</u>, slated for its second reading at our February Board meeting, has been adjusted so the first school day after Winter Break is now Monday, January 2 and so Juneteenth is now observed on June 19. These adjustments mean the last day of school is now Friday, June 16. Snow make-up days if needed would extend school into the week of June 19.
