### State Aid #s released last week...ETSD losing \$1.5 million in state funding in 2022-23

Positively viewed, this is a bit less than the \$1,652,000 loss projected. On the other hand, it is still a loss of \$1.5 million, part of \$7.6 million in state aid reductions over 7 years. ETSD's 2022-23 tentative budget is being presented and recommended for approval at the March 24 Board meeting. For larger context, there are 40 districts in Burlington county. In total dollars, we are losing more than any district in our county, except one. As a percentage reduction, we are losing more than any district in the county except three, with a combined student population less than ETSD's. I will share future updates regarding budget and funding.

Resolution Establishing ETSD As a Stigma Free Zone for Mental Health and Mental Illness Awareness Mental, physical, and emotional health for all is a focus every week in ETSD, including this week, which is officially School Wellness Week in our district. Wellness activities are taking place this week throughout our schools. At this district level, recommended for Board approval next week is this County Stigma Free District Resolution for ETSD designating our district as a stigma free zone for mental health and mental illness awareness. Youth mental health was an area of challenge everywhere prior to the pandemic, and only more so since. The mental health of adults is under strain as well, based on many available metrics. A related component is the increasingly clear connection between youth mental health and social media use. Linked below is the BCASA resolution calling for regulatory oversight for use of social media in adolescents, adopted by our county association of superintendents this fall.
