And another, our district is glad to be supporting the <u>Ukrainian Relief Drive</u>, <u>April 25-May 21</u>, going on now through May 21, organized by an ETSD family, the Lukianovichs. Everyone is encouraged to drop off supplies at our schools up through Friday, May 20. Each school has a collection bin in the main office area. These supplies will go to the Ukrainian American Relief Committee and be transported to Ukraine. <u>Supplies Needed by Ukrainian American Relief Committee</u> include medical supplies, hygiene items, baby formula, linens, and more. The drive will culminate on Saturday, May 21, when items can be dropped at the Marlton Middle School parking lot from 9 am to 11:30 am. The goal is to fill a truck. At 12 pm that day, the truck will start its drive to the Ukrainian American Sports Center in Horsham, PA, accompanied by anyone who signs up to ride along. NJ Senate Committee Testimony

Evesham Township School District parent Kelly Wilk testified at the NJ Senate Budget and Appropriations Committee on April 21. Many thanks, Ms. Wilk! Her testimony is linked below, along with the prior testimonies from Board President Lea Ryan, Board Vice President Aneesh Kanthan, and me.

Our messages: to increase funding to the 182 school districts like ours that are losing it, and to provide funding in all districts to support full day kindergarten. Since 2018-19, our district's state funding has decreased 46%, with more cuts coming, totaling nearly \$8 million. This drop is negatively disproportionate to the change in our student population, which has dropped 19% from its peak.
