Superintendent Comments from June 23 BOE meeting

After all those wonderful student presentations, with 63 students recognized, including 57 Student Council fifth-graders who raised nearly \$4,000 for a K-9 memorial for Evesham Police, I will try to keep my remarks short and sweet. These students recognized tonight are Change Makers. Speaking of change makers, earlier today, 6ABC news aired a segment about a project created by one of our 4th graders, Natalie Rogers, to raise funds for the non-profit organization RefugeeStrong, after reading the book *When Stars are Scattered*. If you would like to watch the inspiring segment, we shared it out via our ETSD Twitter @EveshamSchool. She and her friends sold their handmade loom bracelets at the school's book fair and raised a total of \$501.79 with the motto, "Every penny counts." With the help of the Van Zant PTO, the author of the book, Omar Mohamed, visited the school to talk with the whole 4th grade (The author was a refugee and is the creator of RefugeeStrong. The book is his story.) *When Stars are Scattered* is a core literature book in grade 4.

And speaking of Change makers, I would like to recognize Teddy Bear Academy and TBA Director Leah Perlmutter for 2 recent accomplishments. Teddy Bear Academy was approved for a \$60,000 NJ American Rescue Plan Stabilization grant. The funds can go to past, present, and future operational costs. Furthermore, 26 TBA staff members each earned a \$1,000 Retention Bonus Grant by completing extra voluntary training, through a grant for licensed child care centers in NJ. So that makes \$86,000 in alternative funding secured by Teddy Bear Academy staff this Spring. Ms. Perlmutter and our TBA staff have been working hard all year to support our families, and this grant is a deserved support for them in turn.
