#### **Principal Retirements and Search Process**

DeMasi Principal Irene Romanelli will be retiring on Feb. 1, 2023, after over 30 years in education. Among many milestones throughout that time, Ms. Romanelli began working in ETSD as a teacher in 1989, and became principal of DeMasi Schools in 2010. The radius of her positive impact includes countless individuals (students, staff, colleagues, families) as well as fostering a caring school culture where students are seen, heard, and valued. I say that not only as superintendent but also as a former DMS parent grateful for how DMS staff and administration helped my own kids navigate those middle years. That's what we strive for for all our students. Thank you Ms. Romanelli for your dedicated service to our kids and community. You will be missed.

DMS/DES parents and MES parents (as Mr. Feldman's retirement date has shifted forward from July 1 to Feb. 1, 2023), please take a moment if you would like to complete the principal search input survey in Genesis by next Friday, Oct. 24. The goal is to recommend the next MES principal and the next DeMasi principal at our Nov. 28 Board meeting, to facilitate a smooth transition and Feb. 1 start date for those new school leaders. That said, if more time ends up being needed to identify the right candidates, we may use an interim principal at either school during the spring, and aim for a later start date (e.g. July 1, 2023). We know how important this transition will be.
