Superintendent Comments from Dec. 1 BOE meeting

I'd first like to highlight a few points of light among our schools since our last Board meeting. Our district-wide Winter Concert schedule started today with Jaggard, followed by our other schools throughout these next few weeks leading up to Winter Break. I'd encourage all our families to attend, and I'd like to thank our district's entire Music Department for their efforts in making these events possible and so wonderful.

Today was also the opening day of registration for our <u>full day kindergarten program</u> and <u>preschool integrated program</u>. Deadline is Feb. 17th. More information available under the Parents Welcome tab on our website. Just a reminder, our district's #1 goal for the 2022 to 2025 school years is to make free full day kindergarten, no more tuition-based kindergarten, a reality for all district families for the start of Sept. 2024, via a ballot question next Fall in 2023. Our district will share more information about the ballot question and next steps in this effort after we finalize our tentative budget this coming March.

Another point of light was DeMasi's first-ever Thanksgiving Dinner for DeMasi ESL students and their families, held on Tuesday, Nov. 22 in this very cafeteria. Special thanks to ESL teachers Allison Spence, Sara Smith, and Rob Fox for making it happen, as well as other paraprofessionals and teachers including Dr. Maria Kruzdlo, and huge thank yous to the DeMasi staff as a whole for generously donating the food. The warm smiles and togetherness felt that evening among the families was a great illustration of not only what Thanksgiving, that special American holiday, is all about, but also what our district is all about.
