#### Superintendent Comments from Oct. 27 BOE meeting

I'll keep my comments brief this evening given that we already had 2 presentations. In the past 7 days, our ETSD community has had both a student and a parent critically injured as pedestrians by motor vehicles, two separate accidents, two different areas of town. Our thoughts and prayers are with both families now and ahead.

This is heartbreaking. I would just ask, for all of us, and anyone we know, please, let's drive slower, let's keep our heads up and eyes forward, let's do what we can to keep our roads and walkways safe. Especially as the days get shorter, it gets dark earlier, and the weather gets worse.

My Update for Staff & Families tomorrow will have information and a <u>survey link</u> from The Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commission. <u>DVRPC</u> serves as the regional planning agency for the Greater Philadelphia area, providing guidance and assistance to build a sustainable and livable region. DVRPC is currently seeking input from all Marlton residents specifically to create a safer pedestrian and bicycle network. They use this information to develop recommendations and work together with our county to improve safety. I would encourage everyone to take a moment to complete this survey and add your voice. That ends my comments, thank you Mrs. Ryan.

### Help improve walking and biking safety

The Delaware Valley Regional Planning Commision (DVRPC) is conducting a Downtown Bike and Pedestrian study for Burlington County in Marlton, Maple Shade, and Mansfield/Columbus. The Commision is interested in understanding where people walk and bike—and where they avoid walking and biking. Feedback provided by residents will be used to evaluate existing pedestrian and bicycle facilities in the downtown areas of Burlington County. The study will end on November 30th, 2022.
