First Oval Office Project at Clark Park with the Living History Youth Summer Institute Aug. 6, 10 AM-3 PM Join the Museum of the American Revolution at Clark Park in West Philadelphia (43rd & Baltimore Avenue) where students from the Living History Youth Summer Institute along with costumed living historians will set up the First Oval Office Project, a recreated Revolutionary War encampment, including handsewn, full-scale replicas of General George Washington's sleeping marquee, camp bed, furniture, and more that served as his mobile headquarters while on campaign. This program is free and open to the public. This event is a culminating public event for students participating in the Museum's Living History Youth Summer Institute, part of its African American Interpretive Program.
