One Additional Day, Oct. 7, of anticipated bus delays due to traffic detour

An additional day, Friday, Oct. 7, is needed for this road work to be completed. *Monday, Oct. 3 will no longer be used.* Construction will be 9 am - 3 pm to avoid rush hour traffic. There may be some PM and mid-day bus route delays as a result. Location: North Elmwood Road northbound at Main Street, resulting in a detour of northbound traffic on Elmwood Road from Main Street towards Route 70. Southbound traffic will flow freely. Detour route = Old Marlton Pike to Troth Road (Detour Route map). An officer on extra-duty traffic direction will be at the intersection.
