Update and Reminder: New Walking Zones

As shared in March 31's Update and at our March and April Board meetings, new walking zones have been added for Jaggard, MMS, and Van Zant. Last year, walking zones were added for DES and Rice. Additional zones may be needed in future years. Why? 1) Due to nearly \$7 million in state aid loss (and counting), our district has to reduce costs; 2) Our district has a shortage of bus drivers. Anyone interested in learning about becoming a driver, please contact me, and thank you. Our district provides the training and pays the fees. Great way to make a difference. All our drivers can earn health benefits if willing to work 30+ hours a week. Slides 14-19 in our Final Budget powerpoint presentation available on our website show the new walking zones described below. The new walking zones:

- MMS: Briarwood. Students will cross at the crosswalk (with crossing guard) to be built at Washington Dr./Tomlinson Mill and follow the sidewalk to the school. If the crosswalk is not ready by the first day of school, until it is completed, Briarwood MMS students will receive busing with a bus stop near the neighborhood entrance. Bus information will be available in Genesis Parent Portal on August 16. MES Briarwood students will continue to be bused this year.
- <u>Jaggard</u>: South of Brick Rd., west of Evans Rd. encompassing Farmington Dr.
 Prestwould Ct., Sunnyside Ct., Euston Rd., Euston Rd. West, Utica Rd., Verona Rd., and Evans Rd. Students will cross at the crosswalks with crossing guards at Farmington Dr./Evans Rd. and at Evans Rd./Waverly Rd.
- <u>Van Zant</u>: Woodstream north of Greentree (swim club side) encompassing Brandywine Dr., Valley Forge Rd., Yorktown Dr., Yorktown Ct., Charter Oak Lane, Lantern Lane, Hitching Post Lane, and Deltona Lane (not Meeting House Place). Students will cross at the crosswalks with crossing guards at Greentree Rd./Brandywine Dr. and Greentree Rd./Conestoga Dr.
- <u>Van Zant</u>: Fox Chase Rd., Mulberry Ct., Candlewood Cr., Sassafras Ct., Magnolia Ct., Blueberry Ct., Ravens Row, Harrier Row, Bayberry Ct., Arrowwood Ct., and Bittersweet Ct. Students will walk the path from Fox Chase to Greentree (not walk along Greentree) to the crosswalk with crossing guard at Greentree Rd./Conestoga Dr.
