Ukrainian Relief Drive, April 25-May 21

Our district is glad to support the <u>Ukrainian Relief Drive</u>, <u>April 25-May 21</u> organized by ETSD parent Paul Lukianovich. The connections of the Lukianovich family to our ETSD family goes back 3 generations, as Paul's grandmother Olga Hayduk taught at Jaggard and his mom Christine Lukianovich taught at Beeler. All are encouraged to drop off supplies at our schools between Monday, April 25 and Friday, May 20. <u>Supplies Needed by Ukrainian American Relief Committee</u>. Each school will have a collection bin in the main office area. The drive will culminate on Saturday, May 21, when items can be dropped at the Marlton Middle School parking lot from 9 am to 11:30 am. The items collected at each school over the weeks prior will be loaded that morning as well. <u>The goal is to fill a truck</u>.

Please check out this fantastic opportunity from ETPD! "The Evesham Township Police Department is hosting its annual Junior Police Academy day camp. The purpose of the Junior Police Academy is to provide young citizens with an introduction to Law Enforcement. Our goal is to motivate young people to be outstanding citizens and empower them to act as a positive influence in our community. The academy provides an opportunity for officers and students to see each other as people, rather than as adversaries. It will also

transform the traditional role of the police officer into a mentor and a friend, while encouraging our young citizens to be partners in building safer schools and communities. While the students that attend the academy may not want to become police officers in the future, the program instills a confidence and sense of achievement that will benefit them for years to come.

The Junior Police Academy will cover many topics including, Social Media, Bullying, Motor Vehicle Law, DWI Enforcement, Teens and Drug Use, Crime Scene and Evidentiary Processing, Active Shooter Scenarios, and a K-9 demonstration. We will begin each day with an hour of light physical training and military drill.

Applications are available at the Evesham Township Police Department between 8:30AM – 5:00PM Monday through Friday and available online for download at www.eveshampd.org. Completed applications must be turned into the police department in person by the deadline of June 3, 2022. JPA application 2022
We will have two separate academy weeks. The first week, July 11-July 15, and the second week July 25-July 29. The academy will be held from 8:00am to 3:30pm. Recruits are only permitted to attend one week of academy. Spots are limited to 20 per class and filled as the applications are submitted and approved by our staff. There is no cost for the program but all recruits must be accepted through the application process.

Qualifications/Requirements:

- 1. Must be a resident of Evesham Township
- 2. Must be in Middle School or going into Middle school in the fall (current 5th, 6th, 7th, 8th grade student)
- 3. Must be recommended by a sponsor (Principal / Guidance Department, Law Enforcement Agency, a community representative, coach, or religious leader.)
- 4. Must be in good academic standing
- 5. Must be able to participate in physical fitness activities (push-ups, sit-ups, light calisthenics, etc.)
- 6. Must be able to participate in a structured program
- 7. Have no criminal background or disciplinary problems which may preclude him/her from successful participation in the Academy
